ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This letter of understanding is entered into as of the July 11, 2007, between Jamestown Community College and the Cattaraugus-Allegany Counties Board of Cooperative Educational Services School of Practical Nursing, Olean New York.

Jamestown Community College agrees to grant six credits for the first course in its sequence of clinical nursing courses (NUR 1510, Foundations of Nursing) upon satisfactory completion of the following requirements:

1. completion of the Practical Nurse curriculum at Cattaraugus-Allegany Counties Board of Cooperative Educational Services School of Practical Nursing within the last three years with an overall average of 85% or higher.
2. satisfactory completion of NUR 1450, a one-credit transition course required of all students entering the program with advanced standing.
3. successful completion or challenge of NUR 1500, Basic Pharmacology and Dosage Calculations.
4. successful completion of the following required courses:

BIO 2510 Anatomy and Physiology	4 credits
PSY 1510 General Psychology	3 credits
ENG 1530 College Composition	3 credits

5. met any other additional admission criteria required for either the college or nursing program.

This agreement shall renew on a yearly basis unless either party provides written notice of non-renewal at least 90 days prior to the beginning of any academic year. It may also be terminated at any time by either party if there is a major curriculum revision in the courses or programs referenced within.

## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This letter of understanding is entered into as of 10<sup>th</sup> of December, 2007, between State University of New York College of Technology at Alfred and Cattaraugus-Allegany-Erie-Wyoming Counties Board of Cooperative Educational Services, Practical Nursing Program.

Under the following terms and conditions, SUNY College of Technology at Alfred agrees to grant credit for the first course in its sequence of clinical nursing courses (NSG 1108, Nursing I – 8 credits).

1. The student will have successfully completed the Practical Nursing Program at Cattaraugus-Allegany BOCES within the last five years.
2. The student is to complete satisfactorily NSG 2201, a one-credit transition course required of all students entering the nursing program with advanced standing. The course description follows:

NSG 2201 Transition to Associate Degree Nursing 1 credit


This course orients the student to the philosophy, objectives and curriculum design of the nursing program and focuses on the nursing process, therapeutic communication, documentation, skills and computation competency. This course is required for the transfer student who successfully challenges or receives credit for Nursing I and/or Nursing II and seeks advanced placement in the Nursing Program.

Credit for Nursing I will be processed by the SUNY College of Technology at Alfred's Nursing Department chair. There will be no traditional letter grade points for Nursing I used in the calculation of the student's grade point average. The course will be listed as transfer credit, and the student will receive the appropriate number of credits to count toward computation of the Nursing Degree requirements.






