

GRADUATION/COMPLETION RATES

The Cattaraugus-Allegany BOCES Practical Nursing program is a two-year, part-time program; thus, the on-time completion rate is two years from the time of enrollment. In order to complete the program in the designated two year timeframe, the student must:

1. Attain a minimum grade of 80% in all academic courses.
2. Complete all clinical rotations with satisfactory clinical performance evaluation.
3. Meet the classroom and clinical attendance requirements.

Voluntary Withdrawal

A student may find it necessary to withdraw from the program for personal, financial or medical reasons. The maximum length of time allowed to complete the Practical Nursing program will be 1.5 times the length of the program, i.e., students in this part-time 2-year program will have 3 years to complete. When you withdraw from the nursing program, your last day of attendance is considered your withdrawal date.

Job Placement Statistics

Of the 33 graduates from the 2010 Practical Nursing program, six-month post-graduation survey returns indicate that 100% of graduates are currently employed in health care. Approximately 8% are pursuing higher education in nursing or a related health field. None of the graduates who returned surveys indicated that they are not yet seeking employment or have not found employment.
