

TRANSFER STUDENTS

Students requesting permission to transfer into the program will be required to:

- 1) Submit a written request and application to the program.
- 2) Request a copy of transcripts from the previous nursing program attended be sent to the program coordinator; clinical performance summary including hours attended must be included.
- 3) Only nursing courses with a minimum final grade of B will be accepted.
- 4) Receive a minimum of 80% on an assessment test to determine placement in program.
- 5) Complete a lab skills evaluation by coordinator or nursing instructor.
- 6) Take the Diagnostic Entrance Test for Nursing (DET) for learning styles evaluation.
- 7) Submit a copy of a recent physical or have a physical completed, including required immunizations.
- 8) Interview with the coordinator and appropriate faculty.

Based upon space availability and providing the student has met admission requirements, the students will enter the program at the point the faculty deems most appropriate based on prior education and grades.
